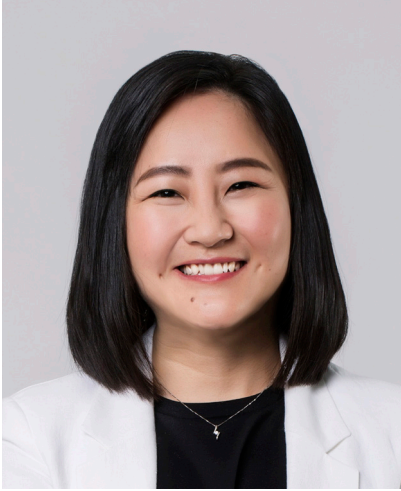

SUMMARY

Linda is a strong and highly valued team lead, frequently heading competition teams in concept design competitions and feasibility studies for a large range of project types. Since joining SAA in 2010, Linda has transitioned beyond residential projects to larger-scale mixed developments comprising of industrial, institutional and aviation segments, building up key experience in managing large multi-disciplinary teams, detailed design, tender documentation, statutory compliance planning as well as submissions and contract management.

Linda played a key role in being the façade architect, responsible for coordinating and delivering the envelope of Changi Terminal 4. To ensure authority compliance while achieving an aesthetically pleasing structure, Linda worked closely with the building team to resolve construction details and provide design workarounds to conflicts, conscientiously maintaining records of all changes and communicating them in a timely manner to all stakeholders throughout the process. She also managed the blast, security and interior design coordination with numerous contractors for authority compliance and submissions leading up to Terminal 4's TOP in 2017. As the key coordinator of statutory submissions in the team, Linda has built strong partnerships with the various statutory departments, many of whom look to her for a deeper understanding of the project.

Linda is currently the team lead for BCA Academy and Changi Airport Terminal 5, both complex multi-faceted developments requiring extensive coordination skills and technical knowledge. With her substantial experience in aviation projects throughout the construction of Terminal 4 and the addition and alteration works to Terminal 2, Linda is well-placed to handle the demands of both projects with optimism and energy, bringing her experience and ability to plan well before time with solutions to address potential project issues in the future to all projects she works on.
